4) Memorial Garden News: As most parishioners are already aware, St. Mark's scattering Garden has been closed since the external work on the church has been in progress. In the interim, we were advised by a Diocesan representative that provincial legislation requires scattering gardens to be at least 15 feet from an exterior wall. So, we are currently creating a new scattering garden in the same general area behind the church. The design will involve paving stones with circular brass discs bearing the name of the deceased embedded in the pavers. Ashes are scattered under specific discs and if family members wish, they may pre-order locations. As previously, names will still be added to the plaque on the Church wall.
